Housekeeping



California Janitorial Services cleans the hallway interiors monthly on the first Wednesday and polices the disposal areas weekly on Wednesday.

They are contracted to:

- Clean the glass entry doors inside and outside
- Sweep the exterior stairs and porch
- Clean the directory telephone
- Sweep and mop concrete entry floors
- Vacuum carpeted areas
- Vacuum stairs
- Wipe down tops of handrails
- Clean the exterior of the light fixtures
- Wipe down baseboards and window sills

The service excludes window washing, carpet cleaning and removing dirt from the walls. If you have a specific concern about the services provided, then please let us know.

Disposal

Your assistance in using the disposal services provided is appreciated. The Board is considering locking the enclosures to prevent illegal dumping. Each time the dumpster lids do not fully close, Waste management bills Liquid Sugar for the extra service (see photo below). Light Check

CDM Maintenance performed the quarterly light check and replaced bulbs. They noted that 10 of the courtyard exterior lights had been broken during Pulte's Construction on Building F. These will be repaired/replaced by Pulte before Building F is completed.

Parking



There are two units at Liquid Sugar that do not have a garage space. These two units have been deeded the four spaces in the central courtyard. It had been previously reported that these were guest spaces, but a review of the parking plan, obtained through a local title company, confirmed that these spaces are for the use of these residents only. They will be marked upon completion of the construction signifying that they are reserved parking. Please do not park in these spaces or anywhere inside the community other than your enclosed garage. Ample street parking is available. If you have a specific concern about the parking, then please let us know.
